You will experiment with the fundamentals of video processing and will obtain legal information.

Music in former times and today! How has the access to music and dance changed with globalisation and digitalisation? Smartphones and tablets are creative all-rounders and are meanwhile offering many ways of combining music and media formation. Music apps convert the devices to instruments by means of which any (un)imaginable tones, sounds and rhythms may be produced.

Apart from the workshops, visiting a high ropes course, playing football, singing and making music as well as discussions and country evenings are on the programme.
